A. Budget Summary and Analysis

The budgeted expenditure for 2026 is estimated at NOK 143.3 million. The main assumptions for 2026 include continuation of activities at similar levels as in 2025 except for a scale up in bilateral support as well as a stable Norwegian krone. The budget reflects a balance between physical and virtual delivery of support. The number of staff is expected to be at similar levels as 2025, with a slight reduction from 53.25 to 52.50 Full Time Equivalent's (FTE) at the start of 2026. The budget includes a 4,0% increase in staff costs, excluding recruitments, for the annual adjustment in staff salaries. For comparison of staff costs against 2025 it should be noted that staff, representing 1.65 FTEs, from Global Foundations are now part of Corporate Support, following the organisational review. This is considered as part of allocated staff costs. IDI will monitor the expenses carefully, balance it against available funding and take necessary action to reduce the scope of activities if needed. Geopolitical developments have reduced IDI's revenues for 2025, including the loss of USAID as a donor. There have also been delays to funding and continuing uncertainty. This has led IDI to curtail activities in 2025, to save funds and finance activities in 2026.

Total income for 2026 (as per contracted and expected grants) is estimated at NOK 143.6 million. Funding in 2026 is expected from the Norwegian Parliament through NAO Norway, Sida, the Austrian Development Agency, Irish Aid, Global Affairs Canada, the European Union, the Asian Development Bank, GCA Saudi Arabia, SECO Switzerland, MFA Norway, Norad, MFA France, SAI Latvia, INTOSAI, INTOSAI PFAC and INTOSAI Journal. A significant part of the funding are earmarked funds that can only be used for specified initiatives/ work streams. These earmarked funds amount to NOK 84.5 million. The balance core or unrestricted use funds amount to NOK 59.1 million. We will continue efforts to engage in dialogue with current and potential donors to secure predictable and long-term funding which is crucial to ensuring the continued ability to support the SAIs.

Continued funding is also expected from INTOSAI as a share of the members' contributions allocated to IDI. IDI seeks to build a small financial buffer with the INTOSAI funds received. In-kind contributions of SAIs continue to be a crucial resource for IDI. IDI receives support in the form of provision of in-kind staff support (resource persons), translation and interpretation services, hosting events as well as. IDI's ability to mobilise in-kind support from the INTOSAI community remains paramount for upholding the level of support. IDI will seek to expand in-kind support from the SAI community during 2026 as well.

The revised budget for 2025 represented a cut in spending to free up funds for meeting spending plans in 2026. This is in addition to the grants received in advance from donors like SECO and Global Affairs Canada. The portion of funds received in advance for spending in future years are considered deferred grants and are not included as part of total income available for the year. The projected carry forward from 2026 is NOK 29.9 million including advance receipts NOK 25.6 million from SECO, leaving NOK 4.3 million as carry forward

excluding advance receipts.

B. IDI Budget 2026

Funding included in the budget is a projection of income for next year. It includes current funding contracts, but we also include funding where we believe there is a high degree of likelihood that the support will be agreed upon. This helps ensure more accurate budgeting by matching likely activities with likely funding. Positive discussions with donors support the assumption to fully carry forward surplus funds from 2025. Expenditure is presented per work stream in four main categories: Allocated Staff Costs, Allocated Overhead Costs, Work Stream Staff Cost and Work Stream Delivery Costs. Allocated staff costs are staff costs from Corporate Support/DG allocated to reflect that the purpose of their work is to support IDI's service delivery. Allocation of staff and overhead costs to each work stream is by the unit's percentage of Full Time Equivalents (FTE) compared to total FTE's. All excess funds are accounted for as Donor Liabilities (i.e. deferred income) and will be carried forward and spent on activities in future years or be returned to the donors. Further explanation to the budget is found in Section H in the operational plans of the work streams.

Global Foundations continues to exist as a work stream, but the work has been integrated into Corporate Support, Bilateral Support and Independent SAIs work stream.
