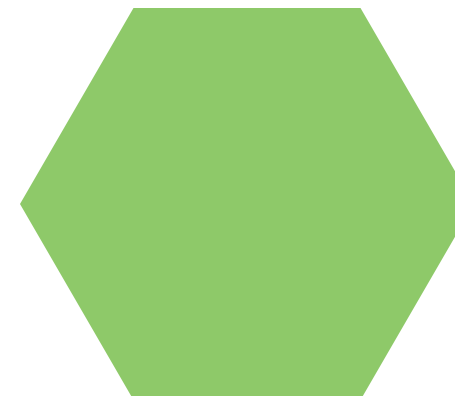


AUDIT OBJECTIVE

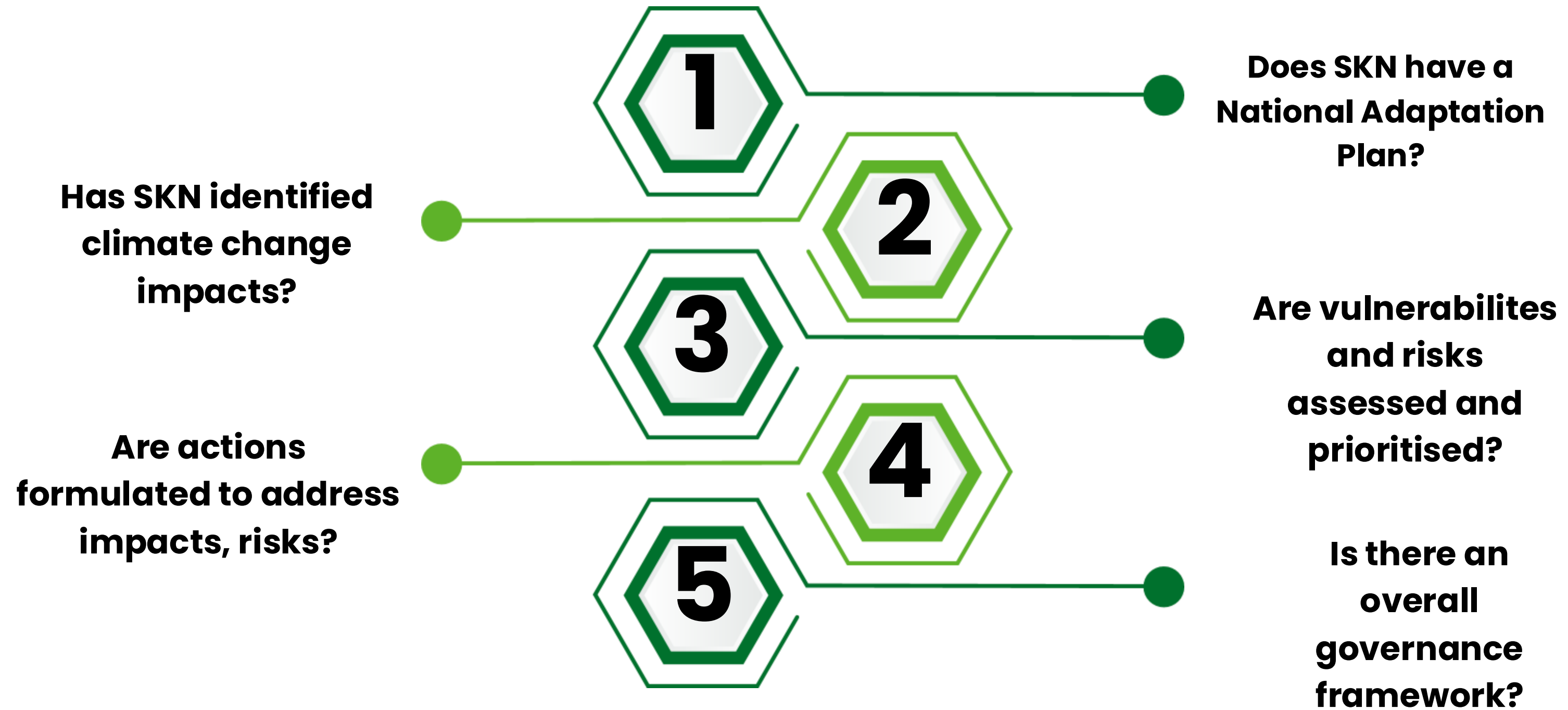


Specific audit objectives are:

National Adaptation Plan has not been revised

Outline of governance framework but no implementation



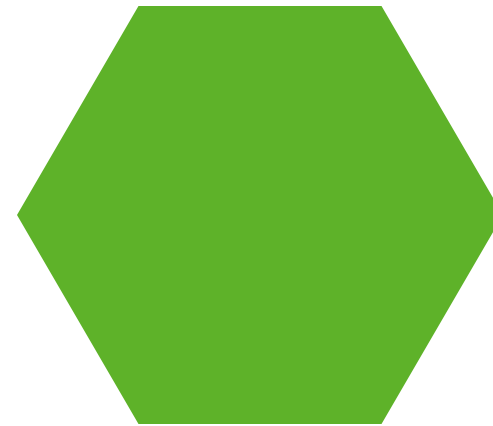
The focus was on Environmental impacts only

Stakeholder engagement strong in the creation of the National Adaptation Plan

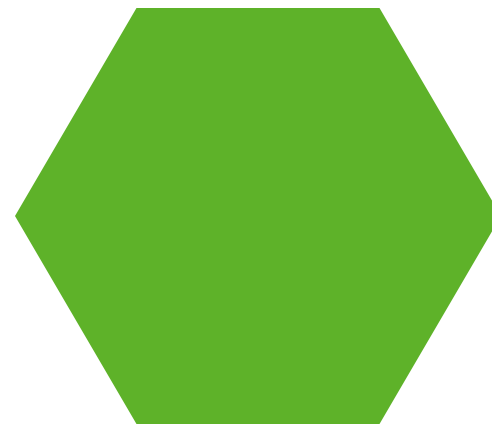


Formulated actions do not align with the current actions

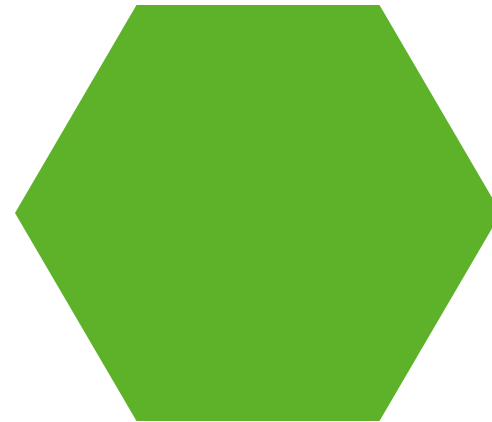
FINDINGS



Costing information was not specific to our islands
