#### Specific audit objectives are:


- To assess the provision of comprehensive climate change adaptation planning.

Does SKN have a National Adaptation Plan?


Are vulnerabilites and risks assessed and prioritised?


No central repository

Different Ministries are all doing things related to climate change and SDGs but not communicating




Unit has 1 full time employee

# FINDINGS


National Adaptation Plan has not been revised

Outline of governance framework but no implementation




The focus was on Environmental impacts only
